

**FAQs -****GENERAL RADIOLOGY / GASTRIC****HOW LONG DOES A “SMALL BOWEL FOLLOW THROUGH” TAKE?**

It is a timed procedure where x-rays are taken approximately every 30 minutes. The time you will spend here depends on your metabolism. Some patients will be done quite quickly but some can be here for up to 4-5 hours.

**CAN I DRIVE HOME AFTER A HERNIOGRAM?**

If you do not have sedation given, you will be able to drive home after a short stay in the outpatient department.

**HOW LONG DOES A PICC LINE (VENOUS ACCESS) TAKE?**

The actual procedure takes minutes but you may be here for up to 1 hour. We will have an IV nurse discuss the care of your PICC line with you after the procedure.

**HOW LONG WILL I BE THERE FOR A SHOULDER ARTHROGRAM AND MRI SCAN? CAN I DRIVE HOME OR GO BACK TO WORK AFTER?**

The arthrogram portion of the test takes about 15 minutes. You will have a wait in between the arthrogram and the MRI. The MRI should take approximately 45 minutes. You should avoid lifting after your arthrogram.
