At Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare (HDGH) we are committed to improving the health and wellbeing of the Windsor-Essex community through the delivery of patient-centred, value-based care. Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare is a unique community hospital offering services in Mental Health & Addictions; Rehabilitative Care; Complex Medical and Palliative Care; and Children and Youth Mental Health. We offer a unique blend of services including but not limited to community and home-based services. In collaboration with our healthcare and inter-sectorial partners, Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare is providing care in new ways and in new locations throughout the region to address barriers, improve access and patient outcomes and improve the overall patient experience.

We are currently recruiting a Geriatric Physician to join our Geriatric Assessment Program (GAP). Located at HDGH in the Dr. Fouad Tayfour Regional Rehabilitation Centre, GAP is a multi-disciplinary program comprised of Geriatric Physicians, a Psychiatrist, a Nurse Practitioner, Occupational Therapists, Physiotherapists, and Social Workers. The team provides comprehensive assessment, recommendations, consultation, caregiver education and support with a focus on diagnosis and management of cognitive impairment, Parkinson's frailty, polypharmacy, and other geriatric syndromes.

GAP services the healthcare needs of the senior population, typically 65 years or older, of Windsor and Essex County with complex health issues and/or a decline in their ability to function in their home.

POSITION OVERVIEW

- Must be able to dedicate at least one full day a week to GAP.
- Work collaboratively with the Program Medical Director, the Administrative Program Director, administrative staff, Professional Staff, the interprofessional team and Schulich Learners to achieve Program goals;
- Provide timely assessments and documentation thereof;
- Participate in organized interprofessional rounds and staff consultation on cases including clinical case reviews;
- Help provide vacation coverage for current geriatricians;
- Other opportunities are available to expand scope of practice depending on interest and experience, including in-patient consultation at HDGH and intake assessments at Windsor Regional Hospital for potential transfers to HDGH Rehabilitative and Complex Care Units.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a Canadian Permanent Resident or a Canadian citizen with a Fellowship from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or other post-graduate certification in Geriatric Medicine or care of the elderly.
- Registration with the CPSO;
- Excellent written, verbal and interpersonal skills;
- Clearance via a Vulnerable Sector screen is required;
- Apply for and maintain a Clinical Faculty Appointment with the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry – Windsor Campus for the purpose of teaching medical learners at the Hospital.
- Ability to work both independently and as a team member within a group environment;
- Demonstrated commitment to quality and patient safety initiatives that support and encourage the optimal utilization of resources; and
- Must complete a full credentialing application and must have their appointment approved by the Board of Directors.
