Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare (HDGH) is the Lead Agency for Child and Youth Mental Health Services in Windsor- Essex. Working together with our Core Service Providers, HDGH provides leadership to ensure that the diverse needs of Windsor/Essex children, youth, and their families are kind, responsive, evidence-informed, collaborative, and family-centered.

A community-based hospital specializing in the delivery of mental health and addiction services throughout an individual's lifespan, HDGH also operates the Regional Children's Centre (RCC), an accredited children's mental health centre working in collaboration with children, youth, and their families who are experiencing mental health and/or developmental concerns.

Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare (HDGH) is currently seeking a Child & Adolescent Psychiatrist to provide two (2) Full days per week (16 hours per week) of psychiatric services to The Regional Children's Centre (RCC) in Windsor, ON.

Reporting to the Program Medical Director of Mental Health & Addictions, the Child & Adolescent Psychiatrist's main responsibilities will include:

- •Work collaboratively with the Program Medical Director, the Administrative Program Director, administrative staff, Professional Staff, the interprofessional team and Schulich Learners to achieve Program goals;
- •Provide assessment and consultations for day treatment children with follow-up while in the program; outpatients; medication reviews; Section 34 (court ordered) youth justice (not forensic/fitness assessments).
- •Participate and support organized interprofessional rounds and staff consultation on cases. Participate in clinical case reviews and observation of children in program and be a liaison for RCC clients admitted to acute psych beds.
- •Provide educational/professional development opportunities for parents and staff including educational sessions, Grand Rounds, and complex case rounds (OTN with CPRI in London).
- •Prescribe and administer medications in urgent and emergent situations; sign-off on BPMH for residential children; and provide joint medical monitoring with ITS nurse.



• Apply for and maintain a Clinical Faculty Appointment with the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry – Windsor Campus for the purpose of teaching medical learners at the Hospital.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- The successful candidate will possess or be eligible for an FRCPC in Child & Adolescent Psychiatry or equivalent, or an FRCPC in Psychiatry and possess experience in Child & Adolescent Psychiatry. Must be eligible for Ontario licensure.
- Clearance via a Vulnerable Sector screen is required.
- Demonstrated high clinical standards with solid clinical skills.
- Excellent written, verbal and interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrated commitment to quality and patient safety initiatives that support and encourage the optimal utilization of resources.
